Archive need: Inventory/Collection Management only; single user access only to database; fully offline; no community online viewing needed.

Archive need: Inventory/Collection
Management only; database online for
Archive staff multiuser access; no
community online viewing needed.

# Scenario 3 Recommendation ARCHIVE DEVELOPED DATABASE

Archive need: Inventory / Collection Management AND Cataloguing; database offline (or server based) for Archive staff multi-user access; no community viewing online.

Software could include Filemaker.

# Scenario 4 Recommendation THE COLLECTING BUG (configured to private setting)

Archive need: Inventory /Collection Management AND Cataloguing; online for Archivist access only; no community viewing online.

# Scenario 5 Recommendation THE COLLECTING BUG (configured to public setting)

Archive need: Archive need:
Inventory/ Collection Management
AND Cataloguing AND OPEN media
online community viewing.

## Scenario 6 Recommendation MUKURTU

Archive need: Inventory / Collection Management AND Cataloguing AND filtered online community viewing (as controlled by the Archive); fully online.


## Scenario 7 Recommendation KEEPING CULTURE


