- invests in and grows the Indigenous media talent pool
- delivers on the ABC's Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP) commitments
- empowers Indigenous media through mentoring opportunities and skills development, as part of the ABC's commitment to support a healthy grassroots media ecology
- establishes strong ongoing relationships with Indigenous communities

- 4. Content collaboration between the ABC and Indigenous media
